Club Membership

Our pony club has the following classes of membership:

All membership classes include fee components made up of Pony Club Australia, Pony Club Queensland, Zone 6, and the local Tewantin Noosa Pony Club.

All classes of membership include personal injury accident insurance provided by Pony Club Australia.

Our pony club uses Justgo to manage our memberships. All club memberships can be purchased through the <https://pca.justgo.com/> web site.

A family volunteer levy (see detailed explanation below) must be purchased through the Justgo online store before any class of membership is made available to members. Contact the secretary for more information.

Life members (riding and non-riding) are given a discounted membership with the local club component provided free or charge for life.



The TNPC Committee

The club's Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held at the start of each new year. At the AGM the current committee positions are declared vacant and nominations invited to fill the following positions:

- President
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- Vice President
- Chief Instructor
- Grants Officer

In order to attract members to volunteer for committee positions it has been agreed the TNPC component (\$49.95) of their membership fees will be refunded after the member accepts the position.

It is hoped this discount will lead to increased member involvement in the club committee.



VOLUNTEER LEVY

Tewantin Noosa Pony Club is a not for profit volunteer-based club receiving no financial support from council or the government. Without the support, help and assistance of members and their families, our club will not survive. Our club survives on income generated from our canteen, nominations from events and assistance from members helping to keep our grounds maintained. If we don't receive these types of support, we have to pay for outside companies to do these jobs we will not be able to survive as a club. We cannot stress the importance enough.

- When joining TNPC, there is a compulsory Volunteer Levy of \$135 for each family which is purchased from the Justgo online store **before any membership is accepted.**
- If the family can carry out 10 hours per year of voluntary work at the club each year, the \$135 is rolled over to the following year. If not, the money will be used to pay for the work we needed the members to complete.
- There is a Volunteer Hours Log Book on our website. All members are to complete the log book within 2 weeks post the event otherwise it becomes null and void. It is the responsibility of the member to log these hours and keep track if you would like the \$135 rolled over each year.



VOLUNTEER HOURS FORM

Volunteer duties include helping out at events, fundraising such as selling raffle tickets and working in the canteen at events. The club needs the help of all members with our three major events of the year - **Dressage, Combined Training** and **Gymkhana**. Set up for these events and running them on the day is a lot easier if everyone chips in to help. We like to have a Working Bee each year so please pitch in to give the clubhouse, gaol, sheds and yards a cleanout. NOTE: Set-up and shutdown at Muster days is not counted as your hours.

GROUND USAGE

The TNPC has a number of gate keys to give out to members who would like to use the facilities throughout the year.

Each key has a number and is kept against your name on a register.

If you would like a key, a \$50 deposit is required and is kept in the TNPC bank account. The key allows you into the front gate, all the grass arena gates, sand dressage arena and the toilet blocks.

The key stays with you until the AGM each November when it is returned to the Exec Committee and your deposit is refunded. The key can be borrowed out again the following year once your membership is renewed.

Where members have not returned their key after membership has lapsed for more than 12 months they will forfeit their deposit.
